

The .ms file format is a custom yet basic file format that shouldn't need a whole pdf to explain, but has a pdf to explain anyways. There is an example for the 757 on the right. As you can see, comments begin with //. The parser will ignore whitespace and comments, however comments must be on their own line. Regardless of aircraft, all options under Information must be present. This is so the parser doesn't accidentally attempt to load settings for a different aircraft or in a different format. "acfversion" is there incase anything under settings changes due to plugin updates. Everything under the settings comment is specific to the plane. The following table lists all the variables and their settings for the 757.
